New Bus Facility for Coolalinga Improving Public Transport in the rural area

On Monday 26 September the Territory Government is opening a new **park and ride bus facility** on Girraween Road, Coolalinga.

The Coolalinga Park and Ride offers rural passengers a dedicated place to park their cars or bikes and catch the bus.

Services Include:

- Free parking for cars and motorbikes
- Drop off and pick up area
- Undercover seated area
- Self cleaning toilet
- Secure bicycle enclosure
- Lighting and cameras
- Monday to Friday bus services to Darwin
- Monday to Saturday bus services to Palmerston

Go green save money and catch the bus, tickets cost \$2 or save even more and purchase a weekly (Monday to Friday) ticket for \$15.

As a key initiative of greening the Territory, this facility contributes to meeting the growing transport needs of Top End residents.

Members needed for the Alcohol and Other Drugs Tribunal

Expressions of Interest are invited for the appointment of members to the Alcohol and Other Drugs Tribunal. The tribunal is an independent body that administers key aspects of the Northern Territory Government's package of alcohol reforms, 'Enough is Enough'.

The tribunal's role is to review police-issued alcohol bans and make orders that ban individuals who are misusing alcohol or drugs from purchasing, possessing, consuming or using the substance, and may also place them in an appropriate treatment program.

Nominations are open to people from diverse backgrounds who have a strong interest in this area and are committed to helping people 'at risk' through a treatment-based approach.

Members will be appointed who have qualifications or experience relating to the functions of the tribunal, or who meet the criteria for appointment and represent the interests of a community, or region in the Territory.

Nominations are especially encouraged from people representing an Indigenous community or regional area in the NT. Nominations made by Indigenous or community-based organisations, on behalf of an appropriate person, will also be accepted.

Members will be appointed for up to three years to sit on the tribunal, as required. Sitting fees will be paid according to the Assembly Members and Statutory Officers (Remuneration and Other Entitlements) Act. Individuals from across the Territory are encouraged to apply.
