Application for surface water extraction licence S71B Water Act (NT)

The Controller of Water Resources hereby gives notice that a decision will be made under section 45 of the *Water Act* regarding an application for the grant of a surface water extraction licence in Robinson River Community. The extraction point is not located within a Water Planning Area or a Water Control District.

The application relates to the extraction of 14ML/year from the Robinson River from a point within Mungoorbada Community, Robinson River. The beneficial use of the proposed extraction is for Industry for the irrigation of lawns on NT Portion 3975, Robinson River.

The annual sustainable yield for Robinson River varies from month to month. The total quantity of water that currently may be taken from the water resource under water extraction licenses is 20ML/yr. The total quantity of water taken from the water resource under water extraction licences in the 2010/2011 water year was approximately 1ML/year. Stock and Domestic use is estimated to be less than 20ML/year.

Application for surface water extraction licence S71B Water Act (NT)

The Controller of Water Resources hereby gives notice that a decision will be made under section 45 of the *Water Act* regarding an application for the grant of a surface water extraction licence in Ngukurr Community within the Daly Roper Water Control District.

Yugul Mangi Development Aboriginal Corporation has applied to extract 3.6ML/year (until December 2013) from a point on the Roper River 200m upstream of the Ngukurr boat ramp. The proposed extraction is for the beneficial use of Industry for use on NT Portion 1646.

The estimated total sustainable yield for the resource varies from month to month. The total quantity of water that currently may be taken from the water resource under water extraction licences is 88.2ML/yr. Reported extraction from these licences was 6.8ML in the 2010/11 irrigation year. Stock and Domestic use from this resource is estimated to be 85.5ML/year.
