Tree Maintenance works

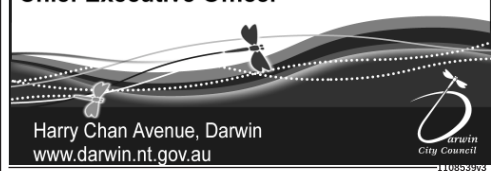
Darwin City Council will be undertaking tree works at 48 and 46 Woods Street CBD on Wednesday 28 September 2011.

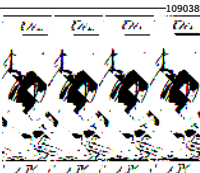
