JUST FOR STARTERS** (R E Laing) 3g By Foreplay - Belle De Rouge (3:1-0-0): Raced prominent on debut for a 2yo win over this course before dropped straight to the tail, eased near 600m, shifted out near 600m, ran wide during race and did well to get up to 2-3/4 len 5th (57.0) Nordic Empire 1000m M Valley 3yo C&G (Bm78) Soft(5) trk Aug 2. Spelled after tackling a Group 3 where he was slowly away and never figured in 8-1/4 len last (55.0) Get The Nod 1100m C'field Vain Stakes Good(4) trk Aug 16. Expect a forward showing first up.

**10. TATLER BELLE** (Marcus Fahler) 4m By Tale Of The Cat (US) - Bella Jinsky (10:1-2-0): Spelled after edged past a couple late for 3-3/4 len 6th (59.5) Juantorena 1200m Sandown-Lakeside (Bm64) Good(3) trk Dec 10. Not much support when resumed, got well back early and ran on only fairly for 4-1/2 len 5th (57.5) Copernicus 1000m Sale (Bm64) Soft(7) trk July 9. Placed at her only start this course this time last year. Rough claims.

**1. GREDINGTON** (P T Hyland) 2c By Magnus - Beswick (6:2-1-0): Resumed from three months off when jumped awkwardly, settled well back and rider told to use more vigour after made some late ground for 2-3/4 len 4th (58.0) Northkape 1000m Cranbourne 2yo Plate Soft(6) trk June 21. Freshened and handled tough going best when dropped to the tail early and made steady ground to score sht hd win (59.0) Just One Moment, Broadway Danza 1300m Warrambool (Metro) 2yo Hcp Heavy(9) trk July 12. Ran a handy fourth in a Group 2 at F'ton only try this distance. Must be considered in this class.

**2. TEE BONE** (C W McDonald) 2c By Bernardini (US) - Pixels (1:1-0-0): Only moderate support for debut where he settled just off the pace and ran home best to score hd win (56.0) Magryte, Asia Spirit 1200m Geelong Synthetic 2yo+ Mdn Synthetic trk July 7. Nice effort first up and should be better for that experience. Worth some thought.

**3. BON AUURUM** (C Maher) 2c By Bon Hoffa - Goldsmobile (2:1-0-0): Slowly away and much the same throughout for a moderate debut 4 len 4th (58.0) Just One Moment 1200m Echuca 2yo Mdn Good(4) trk June 29. Began better and showed plenty of pace to lead for an easy 2-1/4 len win (56.0) Rothstein, Central Witness 1200m Geelong Synthetic 2yo+ Mdn Synthetic trk July 14. Tougher this time but warrants plenty of respect on smart win last start.

**4. I BOUGHT A HORSE** (John McArdle) 2c By Denman - Thorry Issue (3:1-0-0): Spelled after last on debut at Sandown-Lakeside in March. Had a protest dismissed when resumed and came from last on the turn for 4-1/4 len 5th (58.0) Gold Symphony 1200m Mornington 2yo Mdn Soft(6) trk July 2. Favourite, got back early, ran wide during race but ran on strongly to score 2-1/4 len win (56.0) I Want Candy, Lonhro 1300m Geelong Synthetic 2yo+ Mdn Synthetic trk July 10. Has kept improving with racing. Expect a strong showing.

**5. MAIL IT IN** (L Macdonald & A Glyuys) 2g By Reset - Southern Rose (3:1-0-0): Added to a consistent record when jumped awkwardly and came from near last on the turn for len 2nd (55.0) Royal Rumble 1300m Morphettville Parks 2yo (68) Good(4) trk July 4. Vetted - no abnormalities after another honest run when caught wide early, middle stages and again came from well back for hd, 1/2 len 3rd (57.0) Jackey, Al Shameil 1400m Morphettville Parks 2yo Hcp Soft(6) trk July 18. Having trouble winning one but should be handy at the end.

**6. ONE FOR ONE** (P Stokes) 2g By Duke Of Mar-malade (IR) - Stolen Griffriend (2:0-2-0): Spelled after a smart debut where he raced on the pace for 1/2 len 2nd (56.5) Certain Ellie 1000m Morphettville Parks 2yo Plate Good(3) trk Jan 24. Dropped back early when resumed and made plenty of late ground when 3/4 len 2nd (58.0) Jackey 1100m Gawler (Metro) 2yo Hcp Heavy(8) trk July 11. Better for that experience and extra distance should help.

**7. RED ALTO** (Brent Stanley) 2g By High Chaparral (R) - La Sangre (1:0-1-0): Favourite for debut where he dropped back early after slowly away and was disappointed for a run when running on well for 1-1/2 len 2nd (58.0) Equinova 1000m M Valley 2yo Hcp Heavy(8) trk July 15. Needs to begin a bit better but must be considered.

**8. MOST WANTED** (J D Sadler) 2g By Wanted - Ripping Nic (0:0-0-0): First start. Not seen at the public trials. Dam a 2000 mare by Encosta de Lago was placed at four of eight race starts. This is her eighth named foal. Six of the seven to race have won with a total of 14 wins from 1200m to 1730m.

**9. OUR BOY LEO** (R W Smerdon) 2c By Lonhro - Magical Miss (2:0-1-0): Had good support first up but dropped to the tail early and ran on late for a handy 1-3/4 len 7th (56.0) Golden Twist 1000m Cranbourne 2yo+ Mdn Soft(6) trk June 21. Favourite when worked forward early from the widest draw (11) and battled on well for 1-1/4 len 2nd (58.0) Pakaya Prince 1200m Sale 2yo+ Mdn Soft(7) trk July 9. Tougher this time but better for that experience. Has some claims.

**10. PRECISION TIMING** (G Eurrell) 2g By Duporth - Miss Finch (2:0-0-1): Not much support first debut where he raced on the pace, beat most of them home but a fair way from the winner in 5-1/2 len 4th (58.0) Green Card 1100m Bendigo 2yo Mdn Soft(5) trk June 11. Has been freshened since again showed some early and showed a bit more stamina for 2 len, nk 3rd (58.0) Gold Symphony, Prussian Viven 1200m Mornington 2yo Mdn Soft(6) trk July 2. Shows some promise but should find this a bit tougher.

**11. ZANDARRAL** (P G Moody) 2c By High Chaparral (R) - Cassandra Shadow (NZ) (0:0-0-0-0): First start. 5th Lieder 804m W Farm barrier trial Good(3) trk Dec 22. Dam a 2005 NZ bred mare by Johannesburg (USA) won four races from 1000m to 2400m with four minor placings from 27 race starts. She was a Group 3 winner in Perth. This is her first named foal.

**12. CENTRAL WITNESS** (Sam Pritchard-Gordon) 2c By Star Witness - My Central (IT) (2:0-0-1): Not much support for debut where he hung out during race but did show plenty of pace to lead before laid out in straight and struggled late for 6-1/4 len 8th (58.0) Just One Moment 1200m Echuca 2yo Mdn Good(4) trk June 29. Vetted - no abnormalities after dropped back early when inconvenienced near 1000m and made some late ground for 2-1/4 len, 1-1/4 len 3rd (56.0) Bon Aurum, Rothstein 1200m Geelong Synthetic 2yo+ Mdn Synthetic trk July 14. Has some rough prospects.

**13. STARS I** (D K Weir) 3c By Starcraft (NZ) - Siwa (GB) (2:0-0-0): Struggled some early pace from a wide draw (11) but showed from the turn in a well beaten debut 8-1/4 len 7th (58.0) Pure Justice 1000m Ballarat (Metro) 2yo Hcp Heavy(9) trk June 17. Freshened before slowly away and came from last on the turn for 3-1/2 len 5th (58.0) Deja Blue 1100m Geelong Synthetic 2yo Mdn Synthetic trk July 10. Better for that experience and extra distance should help. Look for some improvement.

**14. PARALLEL LINES** (Jason Warren) 2f By Mossman - Media Storm (4:1-0-1): Had good support when resumed from four months off, got back early but was blocked for run near 400m and again near 200m when making late ground for 3/4 len, 2 len 3rd (57.0) Alamein, Sister Close 1000m Racing.Com Park Syn 2yoF Mdn Synthetic trk July 25. Favourite when ran on from midfield for 1/2 hd win (56.0) Jacquere, Sangre Caliente 1200m Echuca 2yo Mdn Soft(6) trk July 13. Wide draw no help but should be running on at the end.

**15. SHINING STAR** (P G Moody) 2f By Exceed And Excel - Off The Planet (3:0-0-0): Made late ground for a handy debut 4th at M Valley before spelled after eased near 600m and midfield throughout in 3-3/4 len 6th (57.0) Misty Waters 1000m M Valley 2yoF RStO Good(4) trk Mar 9. Ran past a couple late when resumed for 3-1/4 len 4th (56.0) Deja Blue 1100m Geelong Synthetic 2yo Mdn Synthetic trk July 10. Better for that experience. Has some claims.

LAZYAXL** (S A Dwyer) 3g By Bianconi (US) - Gypsy Battalia (13:0-0-1): Favourite when resumed from a let-up where he lost ground when jumped awkwardly, settled worse than midfield, overraced middle stages but ran on late for len win (60.5) Dubai King, Brahm's Prospector 1400m Echuca (Bm64) Good(4) trk June 29. Stewards queried run after began a lot better and led for an easy 3-3/4 len win (59.0) Mr Walker, Caprese 1200m M Valley (Bm70) Heavy(8) trk July 15. Wide draw a bit of a concern but must rate highly on current form.

**2. LIBERTY ISLAND** (C J Waller) 3g By Statue Of Liberty (US) - Miduki (12:2-2-2): Freshened before came from well back midway to beat 12 home with a 1-1/4 len 4th (58.5) Dodging Bullets 1610m F'ton 3yo Hcp Good(4) trk June 27. Raced handy, became unbalanced when inconvenienced near 400m but battled on well for 3/4 len, len 3rd (58.5) Raposo, Plan 1600m F'ton Silver Bow Good(4) trk July 11. Not far away at three starts after a win C'bury 1250m (Bm75) in May. Worth some thought at first start here.

**3. VOLCANIC ASH** (M G Price) 3g By Magnus - Silverbeet (6:3-2-0): Freshened before inconvenienced at start, soon into stride and led, blundered and became unbalanced near 1000m but held on well for sht hd 2nd (57.5) Duke Of Brunswick 1400m Sale (Metro) 3yo (Bm78) Soft(7) trk June 24. Given time to settle before ran on from midfield for 1-1/4 len win (56.0) Herstory, Actuarial 1400m C'field 3yo Hcp Good(4) trk July 4. Lightly raced and putting together a smart record over this distance. Hard to beat.

**4. HE'S A GIVEN** (CE Connors) 3g By Any Given Saturday (US) - She's Red Hot (13:3-1-2): Freshened but jumped awkwardly, overraced early, middle stages and closest at the finish in a 3-1/2 len 5th (57.0) Volcanic Ash 1400m C'field 3yo Hcp Good(4) trk July 4. Not much support when led early but overraced early, middle stages and folded up late for 7-1/2 len 13th (57.0) Raposo 1600m F'ton Silver Bow Good(4) trk July 11. Has some claims but needs to settle a little better.

**5. STRONG HAND** (D K Weir) 3c By Not A Single Doubt - Three Diamonds (4:2-2-0): Handy placings first two before odds on when raced on the pace for 2-1/4 len win (58.5) Tatumagouche, Mr Churchill 1200m Sale (Metro) Mdn Soft(7) trk June 24. Favourite again and always handy in a small field before running on best to score lg hd win (58.0) Lord Barrington, Siga La Vaca 1400m Warrambool (Metro) 3yo (Bm70) Heavy(10) trk July 12. Shows promise and better for recent experience. Worth some thought.

**6. ARABIAN BEAUTY** (P G Moody) 3f By Shamardal (US) - Marchelle Belle (5:1-2-0): Spelled after odds-on for an easy win Benalla 1206m F&M Mdn in Jan. Not much support when resumed and just off the pace most of the trip for 4 len 5th (54.0) Shakespearean Lass 1200m M Valley 3yoF Hcp Soft(5) trk June 20. Again settled handy and edged past a couple late when 1-1/4 len 2nd (54.0) Duckworth 1300m Morphettville Parks 3yo (Bm70) Good(4) trk July 4. Better for last couple of outings. Has some prospects.

**7. BENNY DEE** (J D Sadler) 3g By Kaphero - The Gem (14:2-2-0): Freshened before surprised at long odds when handy throughout for lg nk 2nd (58.5) Rationally 1420m F'ton 3yo (Bm64) Good(4) trk June 10. Worked forward early from a wide draw (13), caught wide during race and far from disgraced in 2 len 10th (59.5) Pure Karma 1400m Bendigo 3yo (Bm64) Soft(5) trk June 28. Has won two, placed one of five tries this distance. Worth some thought.

**8. DOLLARS NOT SENSE** (Ms A Johnston) 3f By Omorenomore - Sensuous (1:1-0-0): Freshened before not much support first up where she was slowly away, midfield at the turn, laid in in straight but ran on well for 1/2 nk win (56.5) Gamora, Nordic Noir 1380m Racing.Com Park Syn Mdn Synthetic trk July 3. Tougher this time but drawn nicely. Forward showing would not surprise.

**9. KING'S COMMAND** (L & T Corstens) 3g By Commands - Royal Lineup (4:1-2-0): Odds-on when resumed from five months off with a win Bendigo 1000m Mdn before favourite again but reported there to have some respiratory issues when faded from prominent at the turn for 5-3/4 len 5th (59.0) Benchi Pegasus 1200m Ballarat (Metro) (Bm64) Heavy(9) trk June 17. Settled just off the pace and disappointed for a run when just missed with nk 2nd (59.0) Spirit Cent 1200m Racing.Com Park Syn (Bm64) Synthetic trk July 3. Solid efforts all four to date. Has some prospects in an open race.

**10. VIENNA PRINCE** (M C Kent) 3c By Snitzel - Come Away With Me (9:1-5-0): Freshened before favourite and added to a consistent record when edged past a couple up the straight for sht hd 2nd (60.0) General Custer 1500m Mornington 3yo (Bm64) Soft(6) trk July 2. Beat most of them home but a little disappointing when a fair way from the winner with a 6-1/2 len 4th (56.5) Unassailed 1600m M Valley 3yo (Bm64) Heavy(8) trk July 15. Dropping back a little in distance. Worth some thought.

**11. HELL ON EARTH** (Shawn Mathrick) 3g By Henrythenavigator (US) - Quinsigimond (GB) (8:1-1-0): Stewards queried run and sent for a let-up after slowly away, ran wide early stages but led for a long way in nk 2nd (57.5) Nimbostratus 1850m Terang (Bm64) Soft(5) trk April 19. Stepped up to Listed class but mammoth odds, slowly away and ran past a few late for 3-1/2 len 4th (56.0) Illustrious Lad 1200m F'ton A.R. Creswick Good(4) trk July 11. Better suited here but place looks best.

**12. REINAUDIN** (P G Moody) 3g By Sebring - La Goulee (5:1-1-1): Second up from five months off when slowly away and came from worse than midfield midway for an easy 2 len win (58.0) Grey Sambucca, Transcendre 1200m Geelong Synthetic 3yo Mdn Synthetic trk June 23. Stewards queried run after slowly away, settled at the tail, laid in in straight and plodded on for 3-1/4 len 5th (59.0) Ovahead 1200m Geelong Synthetic (Bm64) Synthetic trk July 10. Has some rough prospects.

**13. VOLONTIERS** (R E Laing) 3g By Voltitant - Frontiers (7:1-1-0): Changed trainers from Jason Warren before resumed from four months off with an on-pace 1/2 len win (58.0) Bagrat Bullet, Alitaka 1200m Racing.Com Park Syn 3yo Mdn Synthetic trk July 5. Inconvenienced early stages but soon into stride and prominent throughout for 1-1/4 len 2nd (58.5) Seguro 1200m Racing.Com Park Syn (Bm64) Synthetic trk July 17. Should be handy for a long way from the pole draw.

**14. TATAMAGOUICHE** (Henry Dwyer) 3g By Foreplay - Chokkie (9:0-3-0): Freshened before slowly away, blocked for run and again in straight but charged home late for 2-1/4 len 2nd (58.5) Strong Hand 1200m Sale (Metro) Mdn Soft(7) trk June 24. Favourite when again got a long way back and was disappointed for a run when closest at the finish in 2-3/4 len 5th (58.5) Blazing Boy 1200m Sale Mdn Soft(7) trk July 9. Having trouble winning one. Prefer his place options.

**1. JAPHIS** (J D Sadler) 3f By Choisir - Livonia (GB) (9:2-1-1): Showed her usual early pace to lead to the turn but struggled late when 3-1/2 len 10th (54.0) The Bowler 1600m M'ville R A Lee Stks Good(4) trk May 16. Sent for a let-up after led again and held on well for 2-3/4 len, lg nk 3rd (53.0) Noela's Choice, Coronation Shellan 1600m M Valley F&M (Bm84) Soft(6) trk June 6. Led to win a 1400m Listed race at Morphettville Parks in April. Must be considered.

**2. CHIAVARI** (N J Harnett) 3f By Teofilo (IR) - Nova Gen (8:2-1-2): Favourite when raced on the pace for a win Cranbourne 1200m (Bm64) before came from well back on the turn in lg nk, hd 3rd (58.0) Our Harmony, Fascinating Lady 1000m Mornington (Metro) 3yoF (Bm70) Good(4) trk June 8. Has been freshened since only start here again ran on late for 1/2 len, nose 3rd (54.0) Our Harmony, Amarela 1100m C'field 3yoF Hcp Good(4) trk July 4. Should be prominent at the end.

**3. MOSSBEAT** (R D Griffiths) 3f By Mossman - Beatrice (13:1-2-4): Spelled after tackled a Group 2 but ran wide during race and never better than midfield for 3-1/4 len 7th (55.0) Sabatini 1400m C'field Angus Armanasco Good(3) trk Feb 28. Got a long way back and blocked for run near 100m when resumed and ran on strongly for 1-3/4 len 5th (54.5) Our Harmony 1100m C'field 3yoF Hcp Good(4) trk July 4. Rarely far away including a couple of handy Group race efforts. Worth some thought.

**4. ALL ABOUT RHYTHM** (Saab Hasan) 3f By Kaphero - Lady Of The Dance (NZ) (4:2-1-0): Showed pace for a 2nd and a win Geelong 1100m synthetic before ran wide early stages but always prominent and battled on well for nose win (54.0) Star Impulse, Paaratte Pat 1100m Geelong Synthetic (Bm70) Synthetic trk July 7. Led for a long way, but finished a fair way from the winner but did beat nine home when 4-1/4 len 5th (52.5) Herstory 1400m F'ton 3yoF Hcp Soft(6) trk July 18. Better for recent racing. Has some prospects.

**5. CATALEVA** (D C Harrison) 3f By Churchill Downs - Fayrouz (10:1-2-4): Added to a consistent record at this distance when prominent throughout for 1-1/4 len 2nd (51.5) Shakespearean Lass 1200m M Valley 3yoF Hcp Soft(5) trk June 20. Vetted - no abnormalities after stepped up in distance, with the leaders at the turn but folded up late for 6-3/4 len last (51.0) Volcanic Ash 1400m C'field 3yoF Hcp Good(4) trk July 4. Dropping back to her best distance here. Worth some thought.

**6. THELITTLERACKETEER** (P G Moody) 3f By Duporth - Street'em Sheila (US) (3:1-0-0): Surprised at good odds when ran on from midfield for a debut win Kensington 1100m 2yoF Mdn before spelled after prominent at the turn but struck interference near 200m, lost a plate and finished with some lacerations when 7-1/4 len 10th (56.0) Meursault 1300m Hawkesbury (Metro) 2yo Qlty Good(4) trk July 3 (2014). Favourite when resumed but spelled again after raced just off the pace, blocked for run in straight and held on fairly for 2-1/4 len 6th (57.0) Demand 1200m Sandown-Lakeside F&M (Bm64) Good(4) trk Jan 14. Has some prospects first up.

**7. ALL AUSSIE** (C & C Alderson) 3f By All American - Palaris (1:1-0-0): Odds-on for debut in a small field where she raced just off the pace and ran on best for len win (56.0) Vanzana Mia, Felicette 1000m Racing.Com Park Syn 3yo Mdn Synthetic trk June 26. Tougher this time but was fairly impressive first up. Worth some thought.

**8. COURTSIDE** (Ryan Balfour) 3f By Court Command - Zoleen (NZ) (9:1-1-2): Won two trials before resumed from four months off and ran on from just off the pace for a len 2nd (57.0) Trupt 1100m M'ville 3yo (Bm62) Good(4) trk June 27. Had good support when always handy and not beaten far with a 3/4 len, lg nk 3rd (56.5) Roll The Ignition, Fascinating Lady 1000m M Valley 3yoF (Bm70) Heavy(8) trk July 15. Far from disgraced at most of her seven starts since a win Morphettville Parks 1000m 2yo this time last year. Has some claims.

**9. NORTHERN FURY** (Matthew Dale) 3f By Northern Meteor - Messalina (2:2-0-0): Favourite for debut where she raced just off the pace and cleared out late for an easy 3-1/4 len win (57.0) Snasybird, Churchill Avenue 1000m Wagga Mdn Plate Soft(6) trk June 29. Favourite again for a similar effort in 1-1/4 len win (56.5) Rusty's Delight, Supreme Lyne 1200m Wagga C'field Synthetic trk July 10. Impressive first two and worth some thought but this is a lot harder.

**10. CINNAMON CARTER** (R E Laing) 3f By Al Maher - Cautious Mission (20:1-6-2): Long odds when ran wide during race, made some ground towards the turn but struggled from there for 9-3/4 len 12th (52.0) Azeema 1400m F'ton 3yoF (Bm78) Good(4) trk June 13. Came from last midway in a small field and still a fair way from the winner when 1-1/4 len, 2-1/4 len 3rd (59.0) Oh Teary Me, A Littlebitofclass 1204m Donald F&M (Bm64) Heavy(8) trk July 16. This should test.

**11. COMIC MISS** (L & T Corstens) 3f By Pins - Centree (NZ) (7:1-2-1): Odds-on for a win Geelong synthetic 1300m F&M Mdn before just off the pace most of the trip in 1/2 len 4th (57.0) Avanti 1380m Racing.Com Park Syn 3yoF (Bm70) Synthetic trk June 25. Dropping back in distance after again raced handy for 4-1/4 len 5th (55.0) Managers 1600m F'ton Rivette Final Good(4) trk July 11. Prefer her place claims.

**12. HIGH DIAMONDS** (Niall Phillips) 3f By High Chaparral (R) - Funlove (6:2-0-0): Ran wide during race when handy most of the trip and swamped late for 1-3/4 len 6th (56.5) Bellarine Rose 1100m Geelong Synthetic F&M (Bm64) Synthetic trk June 30. Favourite when stepped up in distance and led for an easy 4 len win (56.0) Run Neil Run, To Cry For 1300m Geelong Synthetic (58) Synthetic trk July 14. Easy win last start merits some respect but this is a lot harder.

**13. WHITE HOUSE LADY** (A W Noonan) 3f By Commands - Jacqueline Rouge (7:1-0-0): Faded from handy at the turn in a plodding 5-1/4 len 8th (51.0) Shakespearean Lass 1200m M Valley 3yoF Hcp Soft(5) trk June 20. Freshened before making a little late ground in 2-1/2 len 4th (53.0) Roll The Ignition 1000m M Valley 3yoF (Bm70) Heavy(8) trk July 15. Place looks best.

IGGIMACOLL** (R W Smerdon) 4m By Savoie Vivre (GB) - Hidden Moment (19:6-2-2): Spelled and changed trainers from Bill Ryan after dropped to the tail early and ran on only fairly for 8-1/4 len 5th (54.0) Genuine Lad 2400m Launceston Launceston Cup Soft(5) trk Feb 25. Again dropped back when resumed from a wide draw (11) and came from next to last on the turn for a close up 3/4 len 6th (58.5) Pilly's Wish 1200m C'field M Hcp Good(4) trk July 4. Has won two Listed races in Tassie but best form is in slightly longer races. Worth some thought.

**2. SNIPPETEE BEE** (Patrick Payne) 5m By Snip-ptonson - Maggie Bee (26:9-0-6): Beat most of them home but a fair way from the winner after much the same throughout for 5-1/2 len 5th (56.5) I Love It 1200m Hobart Bow Mistress Soft(5) trk Feb 6. Spelled and changed trainers after led for a fair way but knocked up badly in 8 len last (57.0) Vibrant Rouge 1400m Launceston Vamos Stakes Good(4) trk Feb 18. Disappointing at five starts in handy fields since resumed from a let-up and led for an easy win Hobart 1100m Quality Hcp in Nov. Does race best when fresh. Look for improvement.

**3. FLASH OF DOUBT** (R D Griffiths) 6m By Not A Single Doubt - Resplendent (48:8-7-4): Surprised at long odds when made steady ground for a win M Valley 1200m M Hcp before ran wide during race, made a little ground towards the turn but only plodded from there in 3-1/4 len 6th (57.0) Wild Rain 1000m M Valley F&M (Bm90) Soft(5) trk June 20. Ran wide during race and dropped back from handy early for 7-1/2 len 11th (55.0) Pilly's Wish 1200m C'field M Hcp Good(4) trk July 4. Only placed one of five this course but has turned in some fair runs. Worth some thought.

**4. PILLY'S WISH** (M G Price) 4m By Bel Esprit - Excelsion (15:4-3-2): Favourite when resumed from six months off and came from last on the turn for a win M Valley 1000m (Bm70) then jumped awkwardly, lost a plate but again ran on late for 2-1/2 len 2nd (54.0) Wild Rain 1000m M Valley F&M (Bm90) Soft(5) trk June 20. Favourite for first start this course and came from midfield for nk win (54.0) Elle Excite, Khatulun 1200m C'field M Hcp Good(4) trk July 4. Should be prominent at the end.

**5. FINE APPROACH** (Ryan Balfour) 4m By New Approach (R) - Two Under Par (IR) (18:6-0-6): Freshened but blew the start by 3 len and did well to get up to 1-3/4 len, 1/2 nk 3rd (55.0) Red Eclipse, Kosciuszko's Side 1200m M'ville (82) Good(4) trk June 13. Settled worse than midfield, blocked for run near turn and was doing best work late in 1/2 len 4th (55.0) Pilly's Wish 1200m C'field M Hcp Good(4) trk July 4. Far from disgraced last couple. Has some prospects.

**6. BET YOU SHE ROCKS** (M M Laurie) 5m By Fastnet Rock - Betty Blockbuster (NZ) (17:5-3-1): Dropped back early from a wide draw (11) and ran on late to score 1/2 len win (53.5) Mumbell, Proper Madam 1600m Sandown-Hillside F&M (Bm84) Soft(7) trk July 2 (2014). Sent for a long break after well back throughout in 5-1/4 len 10th (56.5) Reckless Assassin 1800m F'ton F&M Hcp 84 Soft(5) trk July 19 (2014). Has won first up but prefer to watch on this occasion.

**7. VAIN ATTRACTION** (D K Weir) 6m By Bel Esprit - Centennial (NZ) (36:5-5-1): Freshened after long odds in a Group 3 and came from last on the turn for a fair 3-1/4 len 6th (55.5) Hazard 1200m M'ville Proud Miss Stks Good(4) trk May 16. Vetted - no abnormalities and sent for a let-up after never got warm in 9-1/4 len last (55.5) Flash Of Doubt 1200m M Valley M Hcp Soft(6) trk June 6. Disappointing in eight starts since a win over this course M (Bm90) last Sept. A lot of those runs have been in better fields than this. Improvement would not surprise.

**8. FORGERSSE** (Q J Scott) 5m By Excellent Art (GB) - Secret Trick (21:4-7-5): Strong 2nd Flem 1200m M (Bm70) before disappointing when only plodded past a couple late for 5-1/4 len 7th (52.5) Jessy Belle 1400m F'ton M Hcp Good(4) trk June 27. Dropped in class and favourite when handled tough going best and ran on from midfield for 3/4 len win (56.0) Maddison, Longchamp Belle 1200m Warrnambool (Metro) F&M (Bm78) Heavy(10) trk July 12. Only start here ran a strong second over this course this time last year. Worth some thought.

**9. YOUNG TIGERS JEUNY** (D Hayes & T Dabernig) 4m By Hat That Tiger (US) - Young Doctor (24:4-3-3): Freshened and changed trainers from Symon Wilde before ran on from midfield for 1-1/4 len, 1/2 hd 3rd (59.0) La Passe, Forgersse 1200m F'ton M (Bm70) Good(4) trk June 10. Jumped awkwardly, inconvenienced early stages and settled back in a small field then shifted in near 100m but ran home strongly for 1-3/4 len win (57.0) Syzygy Blossom, Domino Vitale 1200m Racing.Com Park Syn (Bm70) Synthetic trk June 25. Same effort last time but this is a bit harder. Has some claims from a nice draw.

**10. NORTHERN SAINT** (M Ellerton & S Zahra) 4m By Northern Meteor - Santenay (NZ) (10:3-1-3): Favourite when resumed from a let-up and became unbalanced when inconvenienced at start, made some ground towards the turn and cleared out late for 4-1/2 len win (59.0) Sarawak, Springlang 1300m Seymour F&M (Bm64) Good(3) trk Feb 5. Spelled after came from midfield at the turn for sht 1/2 hd win (58.5) Miss Softhands, Panarea 1300m Sandown-Lakeside F&M (Bm70) Good(3) trk Feb 18. Has a win and a placing from two tries first up. Should be prominent at the end.

**11. AWARE** (Heath Connors) 4m By Tale Of The Cat (US) - Media (15:3-3-3): Resumed from a let-up and never better than midfield in 6-1/4 len 9th (54.0) Wild Rain 1000m M Valley F&M (Bm90) Soft(5) trk June 20. Led and beat half of them home but a long way from the winner when 6-1/2 len 4th (58.0) Forgersse 1200m Warrnambool (Metro) F&M (Bm78) Heavy(10) trk July 12. Has won three of eight at the distance but this class should test.

**12. BRING A RING** (Matthew Dale) 4m By Sebring - Hennessy Waltz (17:3-0-4): Changed trainers from Tony McEvoy before resumed from nine months off, raced prominent to the turn and held on fairly for 3-1/2 len 6th (57.0) Queen Of Kariba 1250m C'bury F&M (Bm70) Soft(7) trk June 10. Had some support but disappointed when always near the tail in a small field for 4-3/4 len last (54.0) Chief Of The Clan 1000m Canberra Fly Hcp Soft(7) trk July 5. Racing has been well spaced with limited success since a win Rosehill 1400m 3yoF (Bm74) Dec 2013. Others have stronger claims.

**13. LIBERATED ROSE** (W G Cooper) 5m By Red Ransom (US) - Luminata (NZ) (23:2-4-1): Freshened before always and but blocked for run near turn and again in straight when 2 len, 1-1/4 len 3rd (53.0) Lots Of Smacks, Maddison 1200m
