Father Tyson Doneley MSC OAM

Tyson Doneley was Toowoomba Qld in 1921, the 6th of 7 children. He entered Religious Life as a Missionary of the Sacred Heart (MSC) in 1940 and was ordained a priest on July 2, 1946. Very talented academically, Tyson was also an excellent sportsman.

After 3 years of parish ministry, he joined the staff at Downlands College, Toowoomba, Qld. and within 2 years was appointed the Director of Studies, a post he held for 8 years. In 1960 he began a 6 year appointment as Headmaster of Chevalier College at Bowral, NSW.

In 1974 he was appointed Headmaster of St John's College, Darwin, again a position he held for 6 years. The 6 years after that saw him as Headmaster of Chanel College, Ulapia, New Britain, PNG.

From 1992 to 2002 he resided at Downlands College, spending 6 months of each year helping out at the MSC Mission in India. Ill health brought about his return to Australia in 2003

On Australia Day 2013, Father Tyson Doneley was awarded the Medal of the Order of Australia for his services to

Education. The Chevalier College website notes that he had the unique distinction of having educated three former state premiers -Mike Ahern, John Fahey and Barry O'Farrell. During the last two years of his life, Tyson lived at the St Joseph's Aged Care Home in Kensington NSW.

Gradually becoming weaker over recent evening, July 19, aged 94.

A celebration of his life with Requiem Mass will take place next Wednesday, July 29 at 11am at the Our Lady of the Rosary Church, Kensington, NSW.
