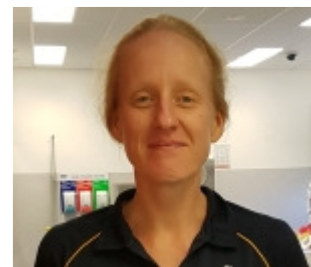
## Aboriginal Health Workshops for students
