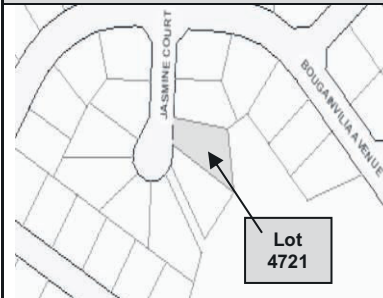

MINISTER'S DECISION UNDER THE PLANNING ACT

I, STEPHEN LEIGH BROOKS, delegate of the Minister for Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics, in pursuance of section 40(6) of the *Planning Act*, give notice that –

- I have, in pursuance of section 40(4)(a), granted a Variation of Exceptional Development Permit for Lot 8642 (3) Coulthard Court, Suburb of Ciccone, Town of Alice Springs.
- The Variation of Exceptional Development Permit has been granted for the purpose of extending the base period of Exceptional Development Permit EDP15/0004 by 12 months.
- The land is within Zone LI (Light Industry) of the NT Planning Scheme, and the development of a building in the zone with a height exceeding 8.5m above ground level would otherwise be prohibited in the zone.
