PROPOSED TRADING DETAILS for the sale of liquor are as follows:

- The business will continue to operate as a theatre and live music venue.
- Liquor may be sold for consumption on the premises seven days a week between the hours of 12.00pm and 01.00am (following day) excluding Christmas Day and Good Friday.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS sought by applicant:

- Liquor will be sold from the main bar in the Courtyard and from a maximum of three mobile bars throughout the Brown's Mart site.
- No more than four (4) cans or bottles of liquor will be sold to any one person at any one time.
- After 22:00 hours, Crowd Controllers are to be employed as per industry standards.

This is the first notice of application. The notice will be published again on Saturday 18 March 2017.

The objection period is deemed to commence from 18th March 2017.

Pursuant to Section 47F (2) of the Liquor Act an objection may only be made on the ground that the grant of the licence may or will adversely affect:

- (a) the amenity of the neighbourhood where the premises the subject of the application are or will be located; or
- (b) health, education, public safety or social conditions in the community.

Only those persons, organisations or groups described in Section 47F (3) of the Liquor Act may make an objection. Section 47G of the Liquor Act requires the Director-General of Licensing to inform the applicant of the substance of any objection. This will include the identity and where relevant the address of the objector. Objections to this application should be lodged in writing with the Director-General of Licensing within thirty (30) days of the commencement date of the objection period.
