Darryl James Evans v. Attorney-General of the Northern Territory

We wish to advise that we have recently received a letter from the Attorney-General dated 16 instant advising that he will now make payment of the sum of \$4,000.00, the amount specified in the Order to our client. We note that in a letter dated 6 February last the Attorney-General indicated he was recommending an ex gratia payment on account of legal costs although we note we have not received any such payment.

In order to finalise the matter of our originating motion between our client and the Attorney-General, we advise that we require agreement to pay our client's costs on that proceeding. We also enquire as to whether the Attorney-General is prepared to make an ex gratia payment for the costs incurred by our client in attempting to execute the order against the offender as required by the Attorney-General in his letters dated 17 February 1988 and 25 March 1988.
