The attached instruments transfer excess appropriations available for a purpose of an agency to the purposes of another agency under section 20 of the *Financial Management Act 1995*, and increase the allocation for Commonwealth appropriation under section 19A of the *Financial Management Act 1995* for 2018-19.

In accordance with section 19A(5) of the *Financial Management Act*, Commonwealth appropriation has increased by a combined total of \$208.735 million in 2018-19 from the original allocation as per the *Appropriation Act 2018*, as a result of an increase in Commonwealth funding for specific purpose payments and national partnership agreements.


