Darwin next for Verdi

VERDI triumphed in the latest round of the FFA Cup when it defeated Stormbirds 4-3 at Ross Park on Tuesday. The next opponent for Verdi will be Darwin Olympic to be played at Darwin Football Stadium on June 15. Verdi soccer coach Gio Morelli admitted to being on the edge of his seat during the gripping dying minutes in which three goals were scored. “It was scary towards the end of the second half but we made it through and it was a good result,” Morelli said. In what was a thrilling finish, a determined Stormbirds threw a scare into the Verdi

camp as it cut into the lead. Verdi seemed home and hosed when it led 3-1, until Stormbirds’ midfielder Ryan Wiggins converted a volley in the 87th minute. The pressure was well and truly on Verdi when Stormbirds’ George Bland headed

the ball into the back of the net in the 93rd minute to equalise. With the game hanging in the balance, Jima Ruach wrapped himself in glory for Verdi when he kicked the winning goal in the 94th minute. “We knew Stormbirds would fire back at us and they did,” Morelli said. “Stormbirds didn’t give up and really gave us a good run for our money in the second half. “When scores were 3-1, I got the boys together and said, ‘Hey, keep your heads up this is still not over. Let’s keep fighting’. “We had a free kick just outside the corner of the 18 yard box with Devo (Ruach) confident of having a go and he took a brilliant free kick. He curled it away from the wall and the keeper got his hands to it but he didn’t manage to save it.” Morelli said his team’s next goal is to improve player fitness ahead of next month’s clash in Darwin. “We do lack a bit of fitness here so we just have to work on getting that up,” he said. In the Southern Zone FICA competition Vikings play Stormbirds tomorrow at 4pm at Ross Park.
