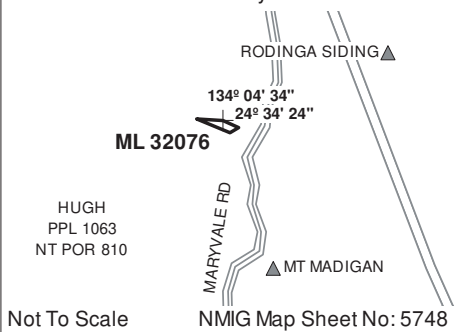
**NOTICE OF PROPOSED GRANT OF MINERAL LEASE**

*MINERAL TITLES ACT 2010 SECTION 71  
NATIVE TITLE ACT 1993 (CTH) SECTION 29*

The Honourable Paul Kirby MLA, the Northern Territory Minister for Primary Industry and Resources and the Chief Executive, Department of Primary Industry and Resources, GPO Box 4550 DARWIN, NT 0801, hereby give notice in accordance with section 29 of the *Native Title Act 1993* (Commonwealth) and section 71 of the *Mineral Titles Act 2010* respectively, of the intent to do an act, namely to grant the following mineral lease application.

**The application to which this notice applies:**

Mineral Lease 32076 sought by PAUL MICHAEL ARMSTRONG over an area of 3 Hectares depicted below for a term of 5 years, within the RODINGA locality.



**Nature of act(s):** The grant of a mineral lease under the *Mineral Titles Act 2010* authorises the holder to explore and mine for minerals including (but not limited to) the processing and the removal of minerals from the lease area and the treatment of tailings or other mining material the property of the Crown on the lease area, including any extractive minerals for or in connection with any of the purposes specified in the lease document for a term the Minister thinks fit and to seek renewals. The term for which it is intended to grant the mineral lease referred to in this notice commences from the date of grant. **Native Title Parties:** Any person who is, or becomes a "native title party" within the meaning of the *Native Title Act 1993* is entitled to the negotiation and/or procedural rights provided in Part 2, Division 3, Subdivision P of the *Native Title Act 1993*. Under section 30 of the *Native Title Act 1993*, persons have until 3 months after the notification day to take certain steps to become native title parties in relation to this notice. **Objection or Submission, Section 71 of the *Mineral Titles Act 2010*:** The landowner(s) of land in respect of which the following application is made may lodge an objection to the grant or the application; any other persons may lodge a submission. **LIQUOR ACT 1978**

**1st NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A PERMANENT VARIATION TO A LIQUOR LICENCE**

The NT Rock Bar Pty Ltd, hereby give notice that they have applied to the Director-General of Licensing for a permanent variation to their liquor licence number 8081812, for the premises known as The NT Rock Bar, Located at Shop 2, 78 Todd Street, Alice Springs, NT 0870.

**PROPOSED PERMANENT VARIATION TO EXTEND TRADING HOURS AND INTRODUCE A LOCKOUT OF PATRONS**

- The proposal is to extend the liquor trading hours on Friday and Saturday nights only from: 02:00 hours to 03:00 hours (an extra 2 hours trading per week.)
- The Licensee shall enforce a 'lockout' of patrons from The NT Rock Bar, from 02:00 hours on any night the premises operates past 02:00 hours. The lockout means that no patrons are allowed to enter the premises after 02:00 hours and those person who leave the premises after 02:00 hours shall not be allowed to re-enter the premises.

This is the first notice of application. The notice will be published again on Tuesday, 9 July 2019.

The objection period is deemed to commence from Tuesday, 9 July 2019, being the date of second notice and ceases at the close of business, Friday, 9 August 2019

Pursuant to Section 47F(2) of the *Liquor Act 1978* an objection may only be made on the ground that the grant of the licence may or will adversely affect:

- (a) the amenity of the neighbourhood where the premises the subject of the application are or will be located; or
- (b) the health, education, public safety or social conditions in the community.

Only those persons, organisations or groups described in Section 47F(3) of the *Liquor Act 1978* may make an objection. Section 47G of the *Liquor Act 1978* requires the Director-General of Licensing to inform the applicant of the substance of any objection. This will include the identity and where relevant the address of the objector.

**NEW ROAD RULES IN THE TERRITORY FROM 1 AUGUST 2019**

To create a safer road environment, new road rules will commence in the Northern Territory from 1 August 2019. The changes are in line with the Australian Road Rules and will improve consistency across jurisdictions. Actions from the Towards Zero Road Safety Action Plan will also be implemented as part of this change.

Some of the key changes include:

- Drivers and motorcyclists will be required to give cyclists one metre in space when overtaking in a 60 km/h zone or less and 1.5 metres where the speed limit is over 60 km/h;
- Cyclists will now be allowed to ride slowly across pedestrian crossings;
- The penalty for using a handheld mobile phone while driving will increase from \$250 to \$500 and a new traffic infringement penalty of \$500 will be introduced for visual display unit (VDU) driving offences;
- Learner drivers will no longer be able to ride a moped; and
- Motorcyclists will now be permitted to lane-filter safely through slow moving traffic less than 30 km/h.
